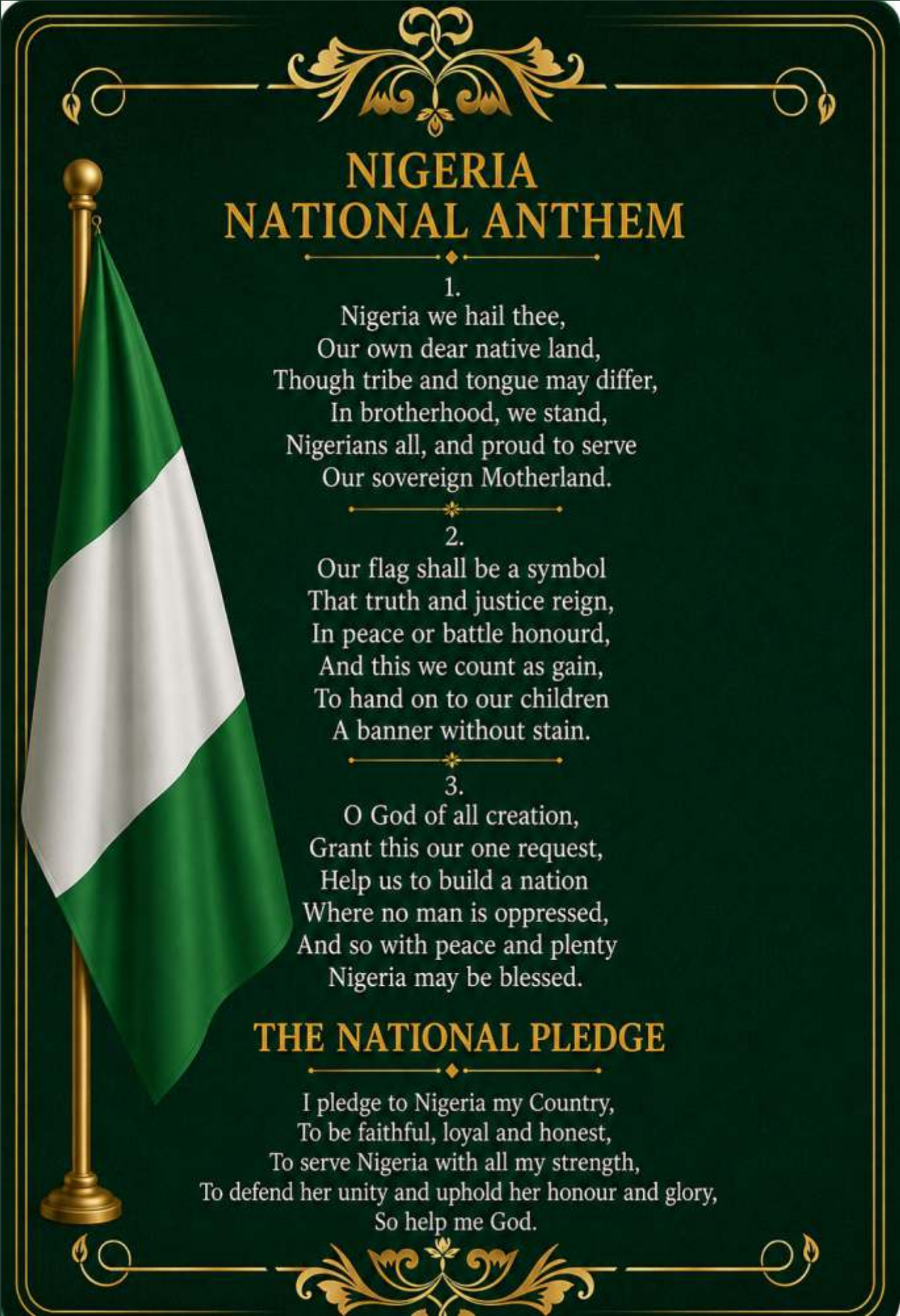

4. The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

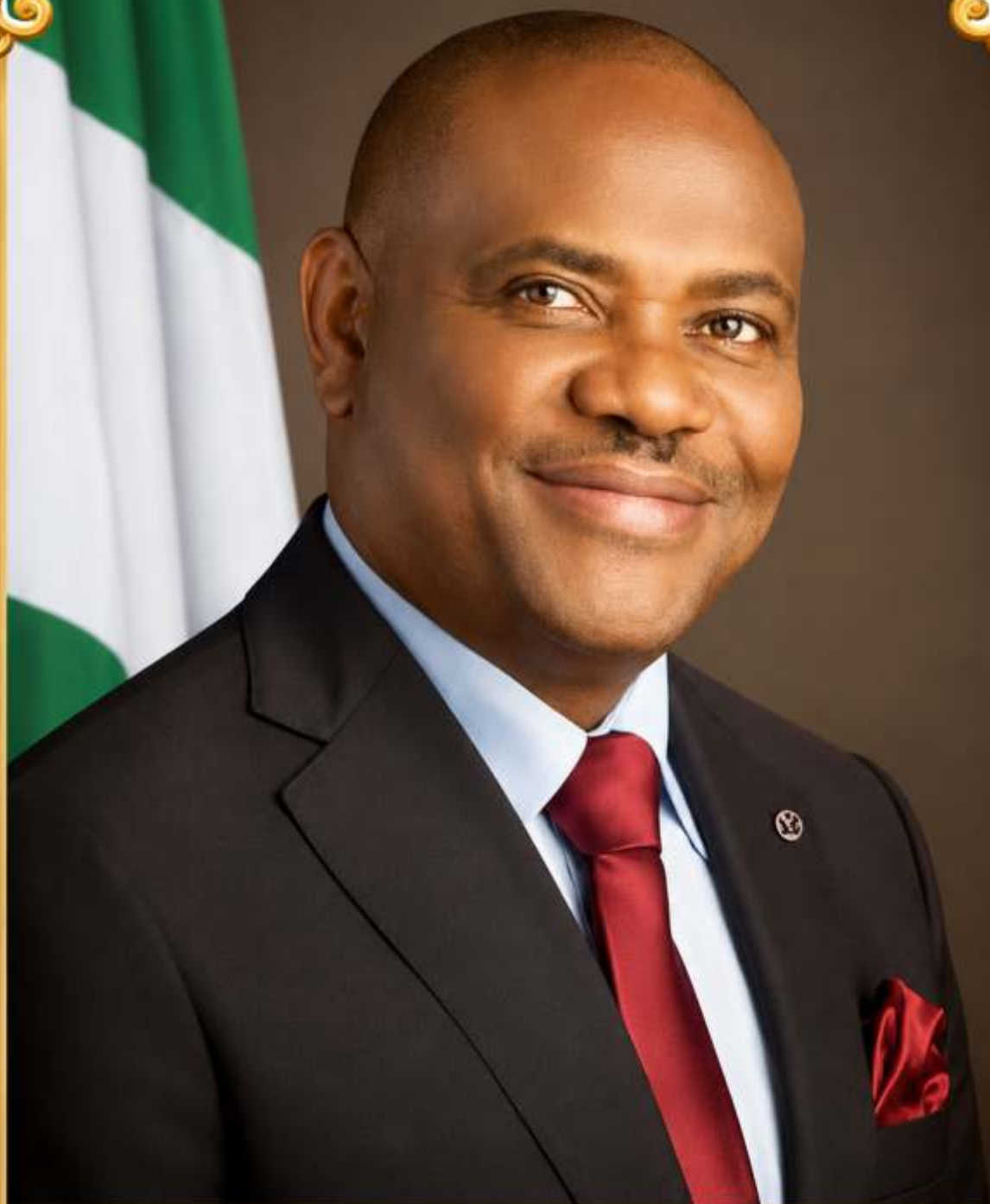
ROTARIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

Paul P. Harris

Paul Percy Harris was born on 19th April 1886 in Racine, Wisconsin, USA at the age of three, Paul and his brother Cecil, age five, went to live with their parental grandparents in Wallingford, Vermont, USA. There, as he recalled in his autobiography, my Road to Rotary, "I was to have the benefit of a well regulate permanent home where nothing was ever either over-or underdone; where ideas were of the highest and education the supreme objectives."

That quest for an education took Paul as a young man both the University of Vermont and Princeton University before he graduated with a law degree in the University of Lawa in 1911. Upon graduation; Paul decided that he will before setting into his new profession

And see the world he did. During his "five years of folly," as he describe it, Paul travelled extensively throughout the United State and Europe.

He supported himself with a wide verity of jobs, working as a newspaper reporter, teacher in a business college, fruit-picker, Cowboy, Desk clerk traveling sales man, and deckhand on a cattle boat bound for England.

In 1896, his vagabonding done, he settled in Chicago and began to practice law. It was there that Paul developed his ideas for a businessmen's club, and on 23rd February 1905, met with three friends -Sylvester Scheele, Loehr to form the first Rotary club.

In the early years of the organization, Paul worked tirelessly to extend Rotary both in the United. State and abroad. When the national association of Rotary clubs, forerunner of Rotary international, held its first convention in 1912 convention, was given the

title of President -emeritus. He is the only Rotarian ever receive that honour.

Paul met his future wife, Jean Thomas, in 1910 while on a day hike with the prairie Club of Chicago, a group of outdoors enthusiasts he had helped to found. Paul and e woods where they first met, he called it comely Nank after the street that was the site of Jeans childhood home in Edinburgh, Scotland.

There, they planted friendship tree son almost every continent as a reminder of the organizational commitment to the world understanding and peace.

Jean were married in July of that year, and two years later, Paul had built overlooking the woods where they first met, he called it comely Nank after the street that was the site of Jeans childhood home in Edinburgh, Scotland. Paul died at Comely bank on 27th January 1947 and was buried in Mount Hope Cemetery in nearby Blue Island, close to the grave of his longtime friend Sylvester Scheile Jean eventually returned to her native Scotland where he died 1963.in my road to Rotary, Paul credit the values instilled in him by his grandparents and their neighbors as the basics for the conception of Rotary. "Rotary was born of the spirit of tolerance, good will and service, all qualities which characterized New England folks of my boyhood days; and I have tried to interpret, so far as lies within me, that faith to other men".

During this period, he established a reputation for rigorous reporting, editorial discipline and sharp analytical insight, helping to shape public discourse during a critical era in Nigeria's democratic development.
- On May 30, 2013, after more than 16 years in senior editorial roles in the print sector, he transitioned to broadcast journalism, joining TVC as Home News Editor. His leadership role expanded rapidly and, on October 1, 2014, he was appointed the inaugural Head of Station for TVC News (Nigeria) at the network's launch.
- An indigene of Ekinrin-Adde in present-day Kogi State, Kolade-Otitoju has since held several strategic leadership positions within the organisation, including Group Controller, Current and Public Affairs; Director of Current Affairs; and currently Director of News. These roles reflect sustained institutional confidence in his editorial judgment and managerial capacity.
- He is widely known as the focal point of Journalists' Hangout, one of Nigeria's most influential public affairs programmes, recognised for its structured debate and policy-focused analysis of national issues.
- Beyond the studio, Kolade-Otitoju has reported from insurgency-affected communities in Northern Nigeria, documenting the human consequences of insecurity and contributing to national conversations on governance, accountability, and public safety.
- A historian by training, he brings together field reporting, historical perspective and analytical clarity. His career reflects a consistent commitment to professionalism, public accountability and the enduring role of journalism in a democratic society.

- Oluwafemi Mathew Akinbode is a renowned environmental justice advocate, public health campaigner, journalist, and policy strategist with over 30 years' experience in advancing human rights, democracy and good governance, environmental sustainability, climate justice, public health, and corporate accountability across Africa.
- He is the Founder and Executive Director of Corporate Accountability and Public Participation Africa (CAPPA), one of Africa's foremost public interest organisations championing environmental justice, public health, healthy food systems, climate action, water justice and democratic governance.
- Oluwafemi at various times led landmark advocacy initiatives, policy interventions, and social justice movements that have shaped national, regional, and global policy processes. Through his work, he has built and strengthened broad-based coalitions, expanded civic participation, and advanced public interest governance in Nigeria and across Africa.
- Oluwafemi is involved in various capacities in public health reforms that culminated in the enactment of national legislations and regulations that included the National Tobacco Act 2015, the National Tobacco Control Regulation 2019, Fats, Oils and Foods Containing Fats and Oils Regulations 2022, the Prohibition of Money Ritual, Ritual Killing, Tobacco Product, Nicotine Product Promotion and the Glamorization, Display in Movies, Musical Videos and Skits Regulation 2024. He is also at forefront of the on-going push for legislative amendment of the Nation's Tax on Sugar Sweetened Beverages tax which was recently passed at the Senate and the advocacy that resulted in the National Sodium reduction guidelines.
- He Produced and Directed Africa's Cooked and Sinking Communities (2023), an internationally acclaimed climate justice documentary that examines the impacts of climate change and environmental degradation on local communities in Kenya, Cameroon, and Nigeria.
- He is the Executive Producer of Sweet Poison, a 2026 documentary that examines the public health consequences of excessive sugar consumption and the influence of the food and beverage industry on nutrition and health outcomes in Nigeria.
- In 2007 Oluwafemi worked along with public interest layers led by Professor Osibajo, Mrs Maryan Uwais, Babatunde Irukera and Dapo Akinosun, to get six states and the federal government to institute the first cost recovery litigation against tobacco companies in the country. He has authored and edited several reports and books on climate change, tobacco control and water justice.
- Before taking into activism full-time, Oluwafemi worked as Sub-Editor with The Guardian where he joined other press freedom activists to found the Journalists for Democratic Rights (JODER), one the activists' groups that confronted the despotic regime of the late General Sanni Abacha.
- He left The Guardian to join Environmental Rights Action/Friends of the Earth Nigeria (ERA/FoEN) where he rose to become the Deputy Executive Director. Oluwafemi currently serve on the Governing Boards of several local and global non-profit organisations and educational foundations.
- Oluwafemi is married and the marriage is blessed with three children. He is a graduate of University of Ilorin.

THE STORY OF ROTARY

From 1905 to Today
More than a century of Service Above Self



1905 | THE BEGINNING

Rotary was founded on 23 February 1905 in Chicago, Illinois, USA, by Paul P. Harris, Gustavus Loehr, Silvester Schiele, and Hiram E. Shorey. They met in Loehr's office to build a fellowship of business and professional leaders. Because the meetings "rotated" among their workplaces, the organization became known as Rotary.



1910 – 1922 | EXPANSION

The first Rotary club outside the U.S. was established in Winnipeg, Canada, in 1910. Rotary soon spread across the world. In 1910, it became the National Association of Rotary Clubs, and in 1922, with clubs on several continents, it became Rotary International.



1911 & 1932 | GUIDING PRINCIPLES

In 1911, Rotary adopted its principal motto, Service Above Self. In 1932, Herbert J. Taylor created The Four-Way Test, a timeless guide for ethical and responsible action:

1. Is it the Truth?
2. Is it Fair to all concerned?
3. Will it build Goodwill and Better Friendships?
4. Will it be Beneficial to all concerned?

Rotary has long championed peace and international understanding. In 1945, 49 Rotarians took part in the conference that established the United Nations. Today, Rotary works closely with the UN and many global organizations to build a better world.

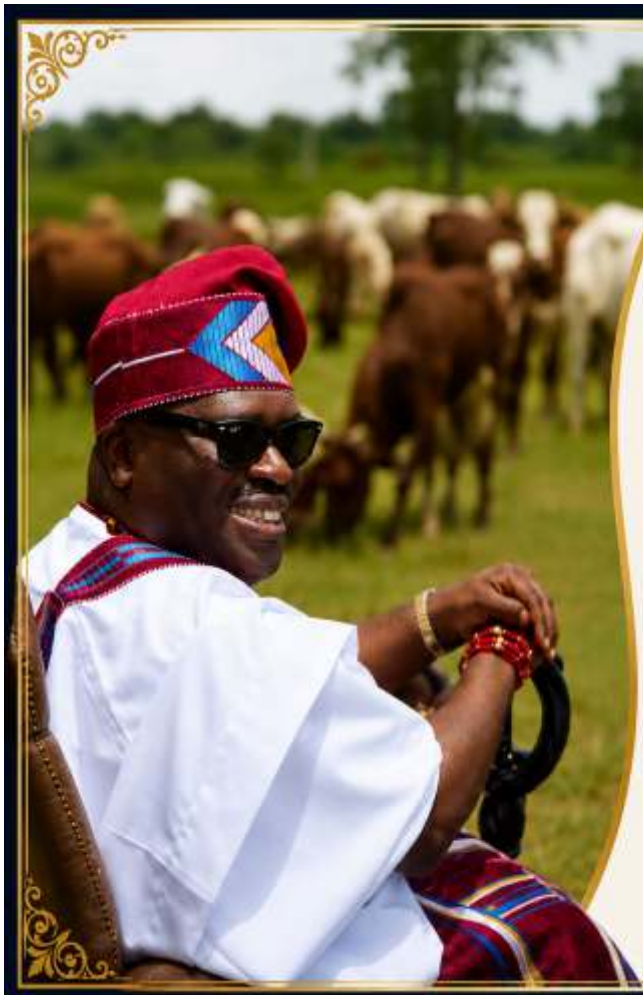

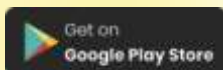
